- Guest Speaker Erin Gaertner (<u>Jobs & Hope WV</u>)
  - Erin Gaertner (<u>erin.gaertner@wvesc.org</u>) is the Jobs & Hope WV Transition Agent covering Berkeley, Jefferson, Pendleton, and Pocahontas Counties
  - Jobs & Hope was budgeted by government in 2019. Helps people in addiction and recovery, and helps adults overcome employment barriers of all kinds (work history gaps, drug screening, lack of driver's license, etc). Works in case management to connect induvials with partners for training (adult education/postsecondary CTE). Work with employers on incentives for recovery-friendly,

second-chance employer practices. Can help with harm reduction training, Narcan/naloxone training.

- Currently working with state park system and other tourism assets to make Narcan available at state parks and forests. Working to distribute "One Boxes" (AEDs for Narcan) to tourism-serving businesses in Pocahontas, Tucker, and Pendleton Counties.
- Jamilia Jones Fleet (Innovative Community Solutions) Is trust a big factor in your case work?
  - Erin Absolutely, our caseload in the Eastern panhandle is mostly male justiceimpacted individuals which requires a lot of rapport building.
- Bob Johnson (AFNHA) Do you work with Family Resource Network?
  - FRNs are huge partners in many counties that we work in, and have acted as fiscal agents for lots of community projects.
- Attendee Discussion / Extended Networking -
  - Michele Moure Reeves (Hardy County CVB) We received an RTP grant to fund the first 3 miles of a beginner-intermediate mountainbike trail at Lost River. We now have contractor to expand our visitor center, and have hired a part-time marketing employee, and will be updating our website along with a new travel guide and campaign. Branch Mountain Bluegrass Festival will be held July 18-20. There is a National Agritourism Survey collecting responses through the 30<sup>th</sup> : <u>National Agritourism Support System Survey</u>
    - Rob Burns We have our Potomac Highlands <u>agritourism brochure</u>, and will be having our Agritourism Summit again in 2025.
