- America250 planned blog series for under-told stories from our area in conjunction with national 250<sup>th</sup> celebration. Grant announcements coming soon.
- Guest Speaker
  - o Ritchie Heath WV Hospitality & Travel Association and WVACVB
    - Legislative recap End of regular Legislative session which passed 333 bills. Governor signed 326 with 1 veto. Passed \$4.8 billion balanced budget (1 million higher than previous budget). Budgeted \$10 million for Dept of Tourism for branding and advertising, ¼ of that for Almost Heaven campaign. \$8 million for destination development.
    - Relevant Bills: HB 3147 created Upper Ohio Valley Trail Network Authority (mirror of mountaineer trail network). HB 3328 clarified Hatfield-McCoy Trail authority to ability to connect trails with businesses and private landowners. HB 3168 updated the Tourism Development Act which expanded qualified projects and costs for the act. HB 3036 expanded Build WV Act (tax credit incentives for workforce housing), removed cap on Build WV districts. HB 3092 creates food truck license reciprocity across county health departments. HB 3311 raised the alcohol limit on table wines to match other products. HB 534 allows municipalities to set up outdoor refreshment areas, allows limited privilege for off-premise sales from breweries, wineries, or distilleries at fairs & festivals. HB 3387 extended moratorium on forming new CVBs until 2026.
