# Phyllis Baxter – AFHNA tourism development mini-grant program

Reminder - With Eastern's partnership, we were awarded a new Benedum Grant this fall that will run for the next two years. As a part of that, we budgeted some funds for tourism enhancement grants and we are matching that with some of our heritage area funds so that we have a total of \$60K available for grants. We are looking for asks from around \$1K up to \$5K for projects that enhance or sustain tourism and we are asking the applicants to provide a 50% match which can be in kind. The applications are due by **March 1**<sup>st</sup> and we are willing to work with you and review drafts if they come in early enough. Please contact Lukas or Phyllis. Many of the inquiries are to see if a project is eligible and about the geographic distribution of the funds. In general, if you think it's a fit and you want to apply, please do so. The applications are not limited to one per county. This is a pilot project so we still have unanswered questions as well.

CDL training enrollments are being accepted now. The first class is on March 28. WV HEAPS is contributing \$4K in tuition recovery. We are still actively recruiting for the 75-hour welding class starting in February.

Olivia Miller - works in marketing/communications at WVU. Over the next several months with be doing a series of marketing training that is free and available to everyone to help you grow your online business presence and connect with your audience. The first one will be available on 2/23 on Eastern's website.

We have also contracted with the WV Hospitality Association to do additional training once a quarter.
