## **Discussion:**

This was sent to the Board on Friday and will try to get it out to the rest of the planning team this week. As soon as we get it posted on the web site, we will share it. If you see anything that is incorrect in how we talked about you, your assets, your organization, or your county, be sure to send us corrections. There is a fairly extensive summary in that narrative that reviewed the following: what are the assets we have to offer, what are the stories we are telling, what are the organizations we are partnering with, etc. It is not intended to be totally complete but if we left someone out, you are welcome to flag that to me but it's not intentional. We had to pick some high points but all of the assets should be in the inventory. We are asking organizations to send up support letters (we will send more information about this). The letters will go into the appendix as well. So whether or not you are

mentioned in the narrative, your letters of support are invited and should simply state that "we support these goals and we would like to participate in AFNHA in the future. Please watch for an email with those links. We are excited that all this work done over the last three years is finally coming together and is almost ready to submit to congress.

• Media Marketing Trainings (Rob Burns)- Olivia Miller is doing the Marketing Messaging training. She will have the next set up on March 30th and the topics will include, How to Build a Brand.
