 - The Appalachian Program promotes sustainable community development by nurturing local partnerships and works broadly in agroforestry. They do research on agroforestry and tree syrups, learning (workshops, certificates, videos, webinars), and community action (marketing co-op for syrup producers).

- Mountain State Maple Days Statewide agritourism partnership between Appalachian program, WV Maple Syrup Producers Association, and WV Dept. of Agriculture. Connects local producers and county CVBs to create community engagement and development opportunities.
 - Mobile sugar shack provides youth education at public events.
